1. Are We Serious About The Scriptures: V.1
 - A. The Word of God must be accepted in our lives.
 - B. Neglect of the Word of God and prayer, is the cause of most spiritual drifting (Hebrews10:25).
 - C. When our lives are right with God, our lives will demonstrate our salvation.
2. Are We Serious About Our Saviour: Vs. 2-3
 - A. How many times have we been found guilty for things that we have done or not done (v.2)?

3. Are We Serious About Our Salvation: V. 3
 - A. We as Christians are to be aware of sin in our lives.
 - B. We as Christians are to be appreciative of our salvation.
