- 1. The Blind Man's Plight: Vss.46-47
  - A. ALL this man could do was sit and beg. No doubt he had heard of the wondrous <u>power</u> of Jesus; and no doubt he wondered if that power might ever be exercised for him.
  - B. When this man's <u>chance</u> came he seized it with both hands. This was unlike the people who heard Paul preach in Acts 17:32
- 2. The Blind Man's Persistence: Vss.47-50
  - A. How do we <u>respond</u> when we face opposition or discouragement? Do we let it affect our <u>service</u> in the Lord's work? This man was not going to <u>allow</u> anyone or anything to stop him.
  - B. This man persisted in spite of the obstacles that lay in his way
  - C. Jesus always responds to faith and rewards those who believe.
- 3. The Blind Man's Plea: Vss.51-52
  - A. The only thing this man had to <u>lose</u> was his sight. No request is too <u>great</u> to bring to Jesus.
  - B. We can never <u>repay</u> God for what He has done for us, but we can always be grateful to Him.
  - C. We cannot acknowledge Jesus as our King unless we love Him <u>supremely</u>, obey Him <u>unreservedly</u>, and glorify Him completely. Warren Wiersbe
