 - C. A true friend will reach out to encourage (Acts 11:22-24), restore (Galatians 6:1-2), challenge(Galatians 2:11-14), instruct(Acts 18:24-26), help(1 John 3:18).
- 2. Paul's Words Are Powerful: V.1b
 - A. As a church member and Christian, my life should be a reflection of Jesus in <u>sacrifice</u>, <u>giving</u>, and <u>forgiving</u>.
