- 1. Are We Serious About The Scriptures: V.1
 - A. The Word of God must be accepted in our lives.
 - B. <u>Neglect of the Word of God and prayer</u>, is the cause of most spiritual drifting (Hebrews10:25).
 - C. When our lives are right with God, our lives will <u>demonstrate</u> our salvation.
- 2. Are We Serious About Our Saviour: Vs. 2-3.
 - A. How many times have we been found guilty for things that we have done or not done (v.2)?
 - B. The word neglect means to recognize but to ignore, to know but to fail to do. If we neglect, the Lord will be sure to <u>correct.</u>
- 3. Are We Serious About Our Salvation: V. 3
 - A. We as Christians are to be aware of sin in our lives.
 - B. We as Christians are to be <u>appreciative</u> of our salvation.
 - C. Warren Wiersbe said "It is easy to drift with the <u>current</u>, but it is difficult to <u>return</u> against the stream." Our salvation is a "great salvation" purchased at a great price.
