1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

Paul encourages and comforts us with five fundamental facts concerning the return of the Lord.

- 1. Revelation: We have God's Truth (Vs.13, 15a)
 - A. God's revelation is based on the historic <u>fact</u> of Christ's resurrection (1 Corinthians 15:51-57).
 - B. The <u>authority</u> of God's Word gives us the assurance and comfort we need (1 Corinthians 15:12-20).
- 2. Return: Christ Is Coming Again (Vs. 14-15)
 - A. What should be our attitude towards Christ's coming?
 - 1. Mark 13:33-37: watch and pray
 - 2. Philippians 3:20: look
 - 3. 2 Timothy 4:8: <u>love</u>
- 3. Resurrection: The Christian Dead Will Rise (Vs. 15-16)
 - A. Paul pointed out that the resurrection of the human body is like the growing of a plant from a seed. The dead body is the seed that is <u>planted</u> in the ground; the resurrection body is the <u>flower</u> that comes from that seed. Warren Wiersbe
 - B. The Christian doctrine of resurrection <u>assures</u> us that death is not the end.
- 4. Rapture: Living Believers Caught Up (Vs. 17)
 - A. The Latin word rapto means "to seize, to carry off".
 - B. Suppose Christ told you that He was planning to come at midnight tomorrow. In what ways would that <u>knowledge</u> affect you? What <u>changes</u> do you need to make to get ready?
- 5. Reunion: Christians Forever With The Lord (Vs. 17-18)
 - A. What comfort do you feel in knowing you will one day meet your loved ones again?
 - 1. 2 Corinthians 4: 13-15: Faith
 - 2. 1 Thessalonians 2:19-20: Hope
 - 3. 1 Thessalonians 4:17: Promise
